Peter Hassall ... Recently came out of hospital after being admitted following a heart attack. Finds it hard going up stairs. He is taking eight pills in the morning and one pill at night for his various health problems. One of the pills is for fluid in the legs and he says that his legs are now 'normal'.

Ian Donald ... His feet are still giving him trouble, and he reports that his Mum is in Greenslopes Hospital. She is eating better than she was and will be 91 in July.

Greg Gabb ... He was suffering from kidney stones and has had to go into hospital to have them removed. Recovering well at the moment.
